Note: A single entry book keeping system was used. A principal cash book summarised income and expenditure on a chronological basis. A detailed analysis of expenditure was then provided by a complex form of day book whereby chronological entries were made simultaneously under a series of itemised headings, and to which monthly and yearly statements were added. Expenditure relating to staff, especially salaries, was summarised in a separate account book on a monthly basis. The only analyses of income extant, apart from the principal cash book, is a series of day book entries for miscellaneous and petty income, and the treasurer's cash book.
