

## Make with the MERL – Hungry Horse

*An easy to make equine with just one paper plate (and do some maths at the same time)!*

1. Cut the paper plate in half and put to one side.  
Cut the other half in to one x quarter and four x sixteenths.  
With the quarter, cut the 'edge' part away from the plate.
2. Pop the 'sixteenth legs' with the 'half body'.  
Stick the 'quarter head' back together as shown.
3. Shape the horse head and ear.
4. Cut the horse head and ear.
5. Turn all the pieces over ready to colour with a crayon or pencil. Colouring the reverse side brings out the 'mane' & 'hooves' from the grooves on the plate.  
Add detail of ear, eye, nose, smile.
6. Stick together and add a contrasting scrap paper saddle and ribbon, string or wool tail.
