

## Make with the MERL – Hungry Horse

An easy to make equine with just one paper plate (and do some maths at the same time)!

- Cut the paper plate in half and put to one side.
   Cut the other half in to one x quarter and four x sixteenths.
   With the quarter, cut the 'edge' part away from the plate.
- 2. Pop the 'sixteenth legs' with the 'half body'. Stick the 'quarter head' back together as shown.
- 3. Shape the horse head and ear.
- 4. Cut the horse head and ear.
- 5. Turn all the pieces over ready to colour with a crayon or pencil. Colouring the reverse side brings out the 'mane' & 'hooves' from the grooves on the plate.

  Add detail of ear, eye, nose, smile.
- 6. Stick together and add a contrasting scrap paper saddle and ribbon, string or wool tail.
