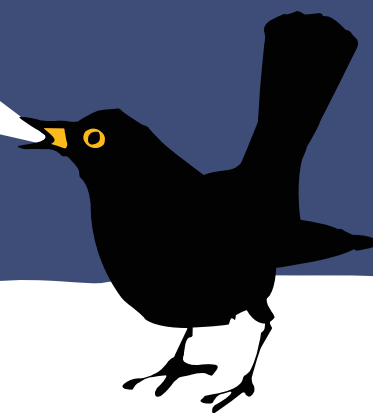


EVERYBODY OUTDOORS

BLUE RESOURCE



REFLECTION, LIGHT AND TOUCH

This activity enables the students to experience reflection, light and colour indoors and outdoors. There is scope to build on this resource by including water features or a visit to a local blue space such as canal, lake or river.

WHAT YOU NEED

- Crystals to hang in windows to split light and create rainbows indoors
- 1 x bottle of bubble solution with wand
- Plastic mirrors
- Flannels
- A bowl of warm and cold water

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

Light and rainbows



Hanging the crystals in the windows, use them to split the light.

Students can use the mirrors to see the rainbow and redirect it around the room. Give students access to warm and cold flannels or shallow bowls of warm and cool water. Note students' reactions and preferences.

Eye on the sky mirrors



Take students on a journey outdoors. Enable students to use mirrors to look around them without having to move their head. Using the wand, bubbles may be blown for, or by the students, to create rainbows.

Reflections



This could include the reflection of people close to the students as well as inanimate objects in the classroom or outdoor environment. Communication that is not face to face may be possible whilst moving using the mirrors to connect wheelchair users and their helpers.
