DEMONSTRATION MODELS

- This model elevator shows a type designed and produced by R. & J.
 Reeves & Son Ltd at Bratton Iron Works, Westbury, Wiltshire, from the
 1890s to the 1950s. The model was made in about 1900 and used in
 demonstrations at agricultural shows (MERL 70/309).
- 2. This model seed drill was used as a teaching aid in the Department of Agricultural Machinery, University of Reading. Such tools enabled lecturers to demonstrate workings of old technologies as they also introduced the latest adaptations (MERL 65/327).
- 3. The ley plough model is of a type designed for re-cultivating meadowland left to pasture. It was used as a teaching aid in the Department of Agricultural Machinery, University of Reading (MERL 62/357).
- 4. The model tractor is based on an International Harvester Farmall M. The crop sprayer is a type manufactured by Farmwork Services in Holbeach, Lincolnshire, during the mid-1950s. The model belonged to a contract sprayer who worked in Norfolk between 1950 and 1975 (MERL 2003/4).

ITEMS ON OPEN DISPLAY

- 1. There are two wooden model ploughs displayed up high near the gallery entrance. These were used at the Festival of Britain in 1951 as part of an exhibit charting the evolution of plough design. They represent a Medieval plough and a Rotherham plough and were part of displays that encouraged the mechanisation of farming (MERL 52/67 & 52/70).
- 2. The large plough is a horse-drawn Kentish turn wrest plough designed to work the soils of Kent and East Anglia. The Museum displayed it during the World Ploughing Championships at Shillingford in 1956, an event characterised by demonstration of full-size technologies, old and new. Like agricultural shows, this was also a context where scale models were used to demonstrate new technologies (MERL 55/786).
- 3. The Ferguson TE20 tractor features the iconic and innovative 3-point linkage, as demonstrated in the adjacent photograph by its designer. The technology is also replicated in the nearby sales model. TE stood for Tractor England (MERL 80/68)
